

DONATIONS OF JGG LEARNING CENTERS IN ROMLECH

As written in the previous quarterly report, JGG has been in the process of turning over its two learning centers in both Romlech and BakChinhchien to the high schools where they are located. Recently, JGG finished repairing and repainting plus adding the cement concrete in front of the learning center in Romlech Hun Sen High School and met relevant

stakeholders from local authorities – village and commune chief – education departments and the school principal. The meeting was conducted on 31st December 2021 at the centre in High School to agree and sign on the terms of the transfer. Now, the learning center in under control of the government, especially under Romlech Hun Sen High School. JGG is still working and collaborating with the school but JGG will "invent" the activities to fit its program changes in the future. In Bakchinhchien Hun Sen High School, the learning center in under repairing and repainting. The contractors will try their best to complete by end of the month and JGG will meet the government and school officials so that JGG can process the transfer as in Romlech.

WEEKEND'S TRAINING TO STUDENT TEACHERS

Since the opening of the school, all Student Teachers meet every weekend to receive the

training in English grammar, computer skill, work skills, and leadership skills, while all 12th grade student teachers were focused on the preparation for comprehensive stat school examination and universities. Due to the COVID situation, all 12th graders were not escorted to the universities in Phnom Penh and Siem Reap, but they were trained on how to browse for the university topics of interests. In this year a total of eight student teachers graduated from Bakchinhchien Hun Sen

High School and Romlech Hun Sen High School. They are now what JGG calls Student Volunteer Alumni (SVAs). They will attend the universities in Siem Reap, and Phnom Penh. They will stay for no charge at JGG's dormitory. Their chosen courses at the

universities are Nursing, Law, Finance & Banking, English Literature, Marketing and Accounting. In January 2022, the new SVAs will begin looking for full-time jobs so they can support themselves while attending university full-time. Before the new SVAs left for their universities, JGG's Director organized a meeting with 12th graders. At the meeting, many topics were discussed including the JGG dormitories, JGG's loan program to help new SVAs financially survive the first year at university, and the importance of choosing a good major to study. The point was also made that the new SVAs should look for the jobs that allow them to keep using and learning English. English continues to be one of the most important job skills needed to get a good job in Cambodia.

FORMER STUDENT TEACHERS' GRADUATION

Five JGG former Student Teachers living in the dormitories in Phnom Penh and Siem Reap graduated universities at end of the year 2021 and left the dormitories. Sun Dalin, Sreyno, Sok Chev Channary, Born Kimseak and Bin Chanthou were the JGG Student Teachers participating in the JGG program in Pursat. They left high school for university in Phnom Penh and Siem Reap. Nowadays, the five are working at private institutions and companies in Phnom Penh with very good salaries.

OVERVIEW OF COVID-19 IN CAMBODIA DURING FOURTH QUARTER 2021

The number of COVID-19 cases was still at risk in Cambodia in this fourth quarter of 2021. Prior to the outbreak up to now, the number of confirmed cases stood at 120,507 cases with 116,929 recoveries and 3,012 deaths (Updated 31th December 2021).

The vaccination process in Cambodia has been still pushing. As of 31st December 2021, a total of 14,262,170 and 13,659,518 from 5-year-old to >18-year-old target individuals received the first dose and second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. 3,588,163 received boosted doses.
