relatives and friends in Battambang and Phnom Penh, etc.

JGG's Regular English Program

In the updating or reporting period, JGG's student population is 762 students. There were a decline from last quarter 977 to current quarter 762 due to the finish of two New American Streamline classes, issues of performance and strict attendance requirements. These measures are to insure the values of a JGG Certificate of their study Completion to the students who work so hard to graduate from the course.

These regular English Program are available for 6th grades to 9th grader students, they are provided with a free three or four year English Language Program.

JGG Director and Project Assistants conducted the regular monitoring to the classes and students taught by student volunteers to check the progresses and performances of the student teachers and students to make sure all student teachers have a very good pronunciations, positive attitude, honesty, neat, clear and correct writing, good lesson delivery and preparation and encouragement toward students, and also make sure all students were very successful in attaining proficiency on reading, writing, writing and speaking.

Meeting with Student Volunteer's Parents at Romlech

In this 4th quarter 2017, JGG conducted the quarterly meeting with the parents of the student volunteers at JGG Learning Centre at Romlech in order to update them about JGG Program and further understanding of being involved in JGG program and how they can explain to their children the importance of education. The meetings were arranged following a schedule and the parents received an invitation from JGG. They participated and expressed their opinions, encouragement and they promised they would have motivated the children to learn hard at school and home.



JGG found that parental involvement or parent's contact to JGG and the program was very important to ensure their children or students to get successful learning, changes, graduations, and good morality because both JGG and their parents always wanted their children or students to succeed and graduated with the knowledge and skills they wished for their bright future.

Professional Teachers from State School Provides Further Training to 12th Graders



At JGG, All student teachers or student volunteers who finished high school are to go to university, but they have to pass the comprehensive 12th Grade Examination taken at the end of a student's high school senior year. JGG provided further training on key subjects of English, mathematics, chemistry and physics - the difficult courses - in the preparation for the national examination. The courses are trained by the professional teachers from the state school.

Regular Weekly Meeting, Learning and Sharing

Weekly Meeting and Learning is regularly conducted at the weekend – Saturday and Sunday. All student volunteers are required by JGG to meet so that they are able to help each other and offer support, to learn about the organizational, English, computer, and work skills required for leadership, and also they are able to offer feedback to each other. In the reporting period, there were many items they were talking about such as the advantages and



disadvantages of learning, internal regulation for all student volunteers, weekend's regular English Program, Team leader for the weekend's regular English program, and the teacher evaluation report.

Student Teachers of the Month



In this quarter, six student volunteers successfully contending the required duties as well as following the rule and regulation of the Student Teachers were selected and awarded "The Student Teacher of the Month". Two student teachers at Romlech Hun Sen High School and four student teachers at Bakchinhchien Hun Sen High School were awarded "Student Teachers of the Month" for October, November and December 2017.
