When Israel was attacked on October 7th, 2023 there were 454 Cambodians studying in the country. One of them was Be-Sreynith (under the yellow arrow in the photo), a former JGG Student Teacher. While some students returned to Cambodia, Sreynith and many others decided to stay, weighing the value of their training, not to mention the money already invested in air tickets, etc., against the risks involved. Message from Sreynith

I am Sreynith. I am a 3rd year student in the Royal University of Agriculture (RUA) of Cambodia studying agronomy. As part of this program, I am currently living in northern Israel. I came here in September 2023 as an intern for 11 months. I will return to Cambodia in August 2024.

While living in Israel I am working in Miriam Shoham Ltd. I am training on how to pack fruit such as clementines, avocados, mangos, pomegranates ...etc. This is the clementines' season, so, my friends and I have a lot of work to do. I am learning about the technology here. It is very important. For example, the land in Israel is sandy and less fertile than Cambodia, but agriculture does very well because of Israel's advance system of irrigation.

The people are very friendly, and they live in a nice, quiet environment. I'm talking about in my living area. I don't know how other people live in the country, especially the cities. Because of the war I am unable to travel from where I live and work!

Five former JGG Student Teachers graduated university in December 2023. Congratulations to all of them! It is a big step!

Between 2016 and 2019, these five students studied English and computers with JGG's English Outreach Program in two rural villages of Pursat province, Cambodia. From 2019 to 2023, they attended university in Phnom Penh while living at JGG's dormitories. They are hardworking students!

Hello! My name is Hort Sreynoch.

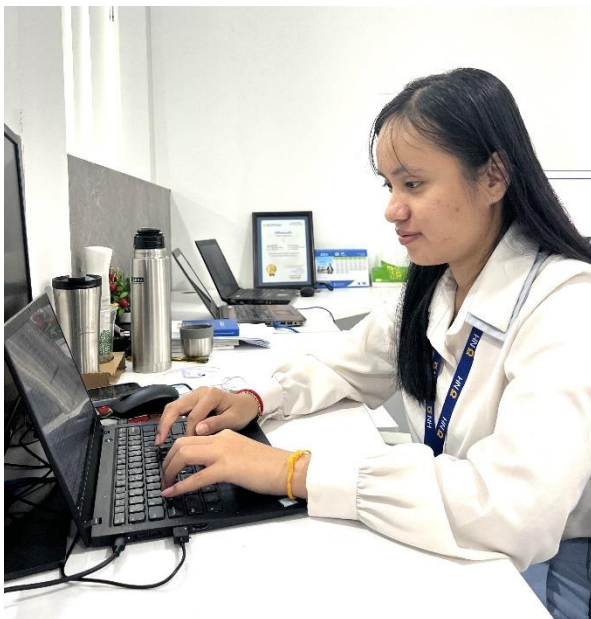
I graduated at ACLEDA Institute of Business in 2023. My major was Financial Technology (Fintech).
